Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro,

I am requesting funding for the George W. Kuhn Drain Headwaters Outfall Rehabilitation Project in fiscal year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers.

The funding would be used for the repair or replacement of existing sheet piling, installation of a natural rock weir, groundwater interceptor drains, a stone toe support, and in stream structures. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will help restore the Red Run Drain, Lake St. Clair, and Great Lakes watershed aquatic ecosystem as it manages the sanitary and stormwater flows of 14 communities in southeast Oakland County.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by section 206 of the Water Resources Development Act of 1996 (Public Law 104-303).
