I am requesting funding for the Oakland County Emergency Management – Archer Barricades Project in fiscal year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is Oakland County, located at 1200 N. Telegraph, Pontiac, MI 48341.

The funding would be used for the purchase of eight sets of Archer Barricades and two sets of Archer Gates, which are steel vehicle mitigation systems designed to prevent unauthorized vehicles access to pedestrian areas during special events. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because the barriers will be made available to all law enforcement agencies throughout the county to increase public safety during public events.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes described in section 1701(b)(8) of the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968 (34 U.S.C. § 10381(b)(8)).
